# SIM: HIT Relevant Updates

- SIM was granted a three month extension to the first grant year (pre-implementation period). Next performance year begins on May 1, 2016.
- An Operational Plan that outlines the timeline, and any updates on activities and deliverables outlined in the test grant will be due to CMMI March 1, 2016 (HIT section March 31, 2016).
- Update on Logic Model:
  - Vetted with Practice Transformation Task Force, Quality Council, Core Team
  - HIT Council Webinar conducted
  - Edits and feedback currently being incorporated

# SIM: HIT Relevant Updates

- **Medicaid Quality Improvement & Shared Savings Program (MQISSP):** Planning for RFP to be released June 2016, soliciting providers to apply to the program. Continuing design work (e.g., provider qualifications, oversight requirements, etc.) . RFP will identify first wave FQHC and Advanced Network participants. Concept paper submitted to CMS on 1/8/16.
- **Community & Clinical Integration Program (CCIP):** Planning to release an RFP to procure a transformation vendor(s) by May/June. Standards currently being reviewed in light of the TCPI PTN federal grant. Final report?
- **Advanced Medical Home:** New cohort of non-medical home practices will be recruited in March, 2016. Current pilot cohort on track to become medical home recognized.

- **Quality Measure Alignment:** Recommended core quality measures and report planned to be released for public comment.
- **Population Health Plan:** DPH is planning to launch the Population Health Council in March or April.
- **Value-based Insurance Design (VBID):** First consortium meeting will take place on February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
